



NAME CHANGE

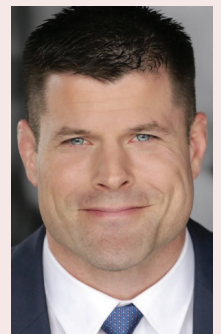
Fort Lee, a Hunt Military Community, located in Richmond, Virginia, will soon be renamed. This large base of over 1500 military homes is one of several Army bases undergoing a name change. Effective April 27, 2023, Fort Lee will be renamed Fort Gregg-Adams. The new name honors Lt. Gen Arthur Gregg and Lt. Col Charity Adams. Gregg was a key figure in the integration of black soldiers into the Army. Adams was one of the

highest-ranking female soldiers in World War II. Other Army bases receiving name changes include Fort Benning-Fort Moore; Fort Bragg-Fort Liberty; Fort Gordon-Fort Eisenhower; Fort A.P.Hill-Fort Walker; Fort Hood- Fort Cavazos; Fort Pickett-Fort Barfoot; Fort Polk- Fort Johnson; and Fort Rucker- Fort Novosel.

COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

Pet Rules for Quail Hollow Family Housing:

- All dogs must be on a leash when being walked, even if you are by your house.
- We need a picture of each pet and rabies vaccination records as well. Non-Military must pay a non-refundable Pet Fee of \$300.00 per pet. Military must pay a \$250.00 Pet Deposit that is refundable at the time of move out, so long as there is no damage to the home.
- Hunt Military Communities does have breed restrictions for Dogs. Residents cannot have restricted breeds or dogs mixed with restricted breeds. The restricted breeds are Pit Bull (American Staffordshire Bull Terrier or English Staffordshire Terrier), Rottweiler, Presa Canarios, Doberman Pinscher, Chow Chow, Akitas, Mastiffs, Great Danes, Alaska Malamutes, and Wolf Hybrids.
- There is a limit of 2 pets per household.
- Please make sure dogs are not barking nonstop throughout the day or night. Please consider your neighbors!

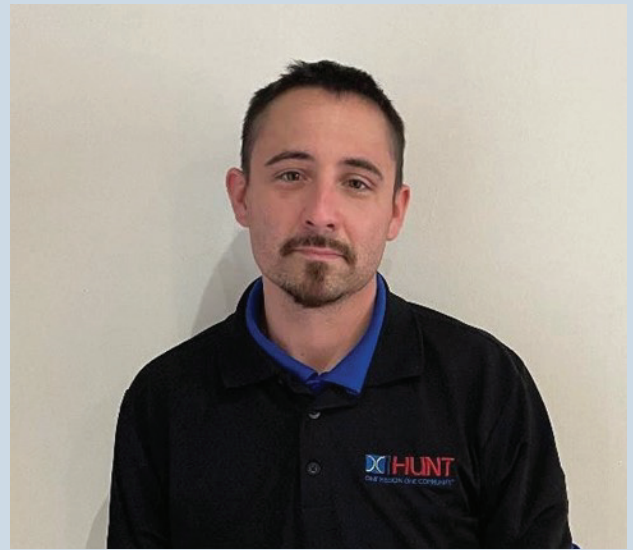

Trash

When disposing of trash, please place all loose trash in trash bags before placing them in the receptacles. Only trash bags should be placed in trashcans. All boxes needing to be disposed of should be empty of all contents, flattened, and placed on the side of the receptacles. No household/bulk items should be placed in or near the receptacles. If you are needing to dispose of household items (couches, chairs, tables, beds, etc.) please reach out to the front office at (325) 313-0200 to get a pickup scheduled for a fee or contact the city of Abilene directly at (325) 676-6053 to schedule an appointment.

In order to keep Quail Hollow beautiful, please be mindful of the area. We ask that all residents and guests pick up after their pets and whenever they are out of the home, pets are to be on a leash per your signed leasing addendum and Taylor County laws.
