Pet Rules for Quail Hollow Family Housing

- Limit to 2 pets per household. All dogs must be on a leash when being walked, even if you are by your house.
- Non-military residents must pay a non-refundable pet fee of \$300.00 per pet. Service members must pay a \$250.00 pet deposit which is refundable at the time of your move-out as long as there is no pet-related damage to the home.
- We kindly ask that you help keep the community peaceful by ensuring your dogs aren't barking continuously during the day or night. Your neighbors will really appreciate it—thank you!
- Please provide us with a photo of each pet along with their current rabies vaccination records.
- Hunt Military Communities has breed restrictions for dogs. Residents cannot have restricted breeds or dogs mixed with restricted breeds. The restricted breeds are Pit Bull (American Staffordshire Bull Terrier/English Staffordshire Terrier), Rottweiler, Presa Canarios, Doberman Pinscher, Chow Chow, Akitas, Mastiff, Great Danes, Alaskan Malamutes, and Wolf Hybrids.
