Clocks Back or Forward?

Daylight Saving Time (DST) is the practice of setting the clocks forward one hour from standard time during the summer months (lose 1 hour) & back again in the fall (regain 1 hour), saving energy & making better use of natural daylight.

"Spring Forward, Fall Back," is one of the little sayings to help remember which way to set your watch. Abilene is in Central Standard Time, so be sure to set your watch back 1 hour.

U.S. inventor and politician Benjamin Franklin first proposed the concept of DST in 1784, but modern Daylight Saving Time first saw the light of day in 1895, when George Vernon Hudson, an entomologist from New Zealand proposed for a two-hour daylight shift.
