Springtime means warmer weather which can also mean more insects! Once the exact location of any nest has been identified call to be added on our weekly Thursday Pest Control list. It 's a good idea to keep a can of wasp/insect spray on standby for any immediate emergencies you may run into Blind/Cord Safety: Cord cannot be longer than 6" when blinds fully suspended * Single strands must hang loose and ends cannot be looped together
